The ECIT Foundation is looking for a new team of interns/volunteers to revive the campaign of our previous ECI 'Voters Without Borders' in the run-up to the next European Parliament elections. Located near the European Parliament in Brussels, the ECIT Foundation serves as a centre for research, dialogue and knowledge-exchange among academics, civil society activists and policy-makers. With the date for the European elections set, we want to protect the social capital generated from the campaign, and continue the work to achieve a Europe of universal suffrage, and full political rights for mobile citizens. As a member of the VWB taskforce, your role will include tasks related to:

Communication:

- Management of the *VWB* social media channels (Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter);
- Assist with the drafting of press releases, flyers and other written materials;
- Mass-mailing of newsletters, event invitations and reminders.

Advocacy and Event Organisation:

- Support the advocacy national strategies for ECIT and *VWB*;
- Maintain and create partnerships with NGOs and civil society organisations;
- Attend and report on external events;
- Assist with the organisation of events both online and in person;
- Assist with the drafting of press releases and the monthly newsletter.

Profile Essentials:

- Being enrolled/previously enrolled in a pertinent degree programme (Political Science, International Relations or European studies, Law);
- Good understanding of and interest in EU policy;
- Knowledge of the EU Institutions and decision-making processes;
- Able to take initiative, work in a team and independently;
- Strong communication skills;
- Excellent written and oral use of English, any other European language is a plus;
- Proactive and motivated.

Duration

Priority will be given to candidates available to join for a minimum of 6 months, but the call caters to full/part-time availability which can be discussed. In addition, remote work may be possible for those who cannot join in Brussels. Our priority is attracting those with the motivation and interest to advocate for political rights.
